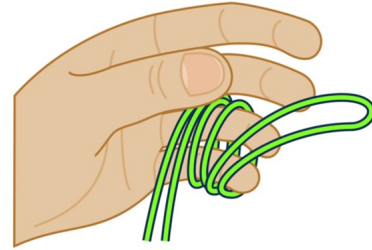


How to tie the FG knot

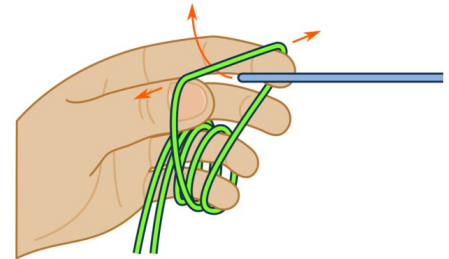
STEP 1.

Apply constant tension to the braided line. The braided line needs to be tight so you can wrap and thread the monofilament leader into it.



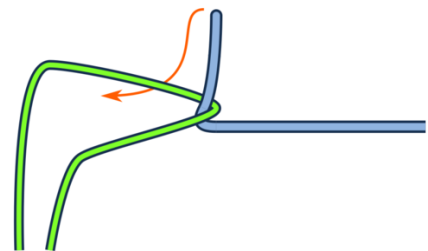
STEP 2.

Thread the monofilament leader through the braid as shown.



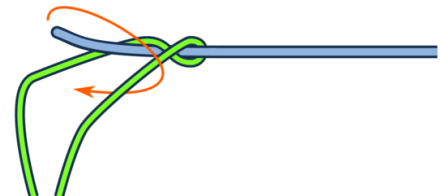
STEP 3.

Open the loop and wrap the monofilament around the braid line once away from you.



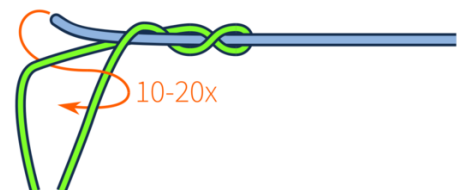
STEP 4.

Alternate the loop, this time wrap the monofilament around the braid line once towards you.



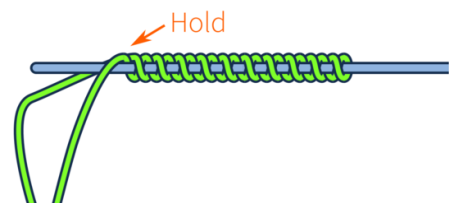
STEP 5.

Continue making this looping motion, looping away from you, and then towards you for approx. twenty loops.



STEP 6.

Continue to pull pressure on the main lines. The knot must have tension, so make sure you keep this tension.



STEP 7.

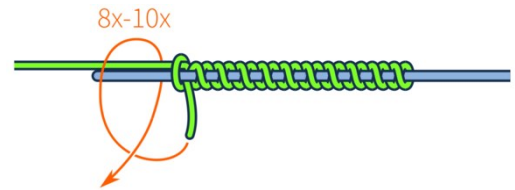
Now, lock the twenty loops in place with a half hitch, to assist with removing tension off the line.



How to tie the FG knot

STEP 8.

Cut off the tag end of the leader. It is essential when you trim the leader make sure the end does not catch on the rod eyelets.



STEP 9.

Make two full hitch knots (not half hitches) that wrap around both the braid and the mono or fluoro leader.



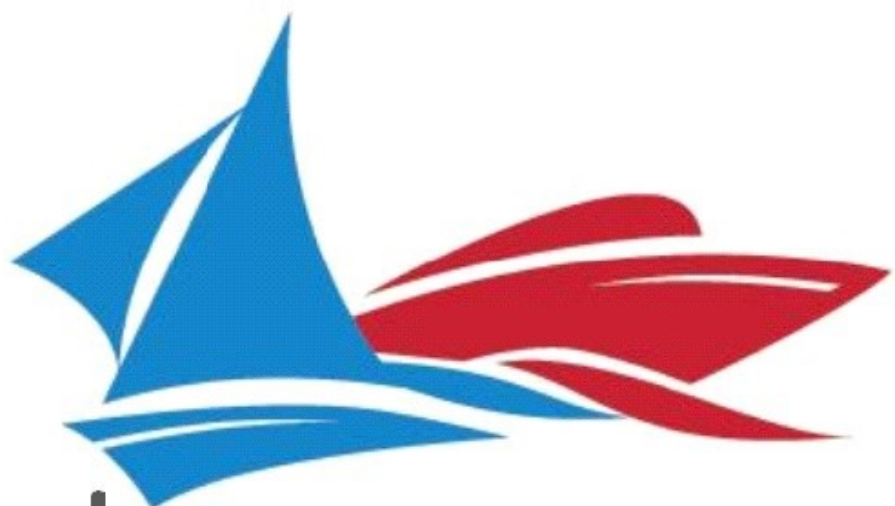
STEP 10.

Pull the two main lines tight, making sure the knot does not slip.



STEP 11.

Cut off the tag end of the braid.
